



Instructions for Gathering Signatures

- Circulators and signers must be 18 years of age and eligible to vote in the state of Wisconsin.
- Circulators should carefully read the language of the Certification of Circulator. THE CIRCULATOR MUST PERSONALLY PRESENT THE NOMINATION PAPER TO EACH SIGNER. THE CIRCULATOR MUST BE A QUALIFIED ELECTOR OF WISCONSIN. THE NOMINATION PAPER MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED ON COUNTERS OR POSTED ON BULLETIN BOARDS.
- Signers should legibly and completely fill out the form.
 - ALL sections must be completed.
 - Each person must indicate their house number and street name or rural route. PO Boxes are not acceptable addresses. The signer must use their address and municipality of residence, not their mailing address (if the two are different) *For example, the voter could have a Sun Prairie mailing address and live in the Town of Burke. Town of Burke is the municipality of residence/ their voting address and what is needed for this form.*
 - *Ditto marks that follow correct and complete address or date information are acceptable. The circulator may add any missing or illegible address or date information before the papers are filed with the filing officer.*
 - Date of signing: please check that each signer indicates the correct date.

Signature of Circulator

- Once you've completed a sheet or are done collecting signatures, you must complete the Certification of Circulator at the bottom of the form.
 - Please legibly write your name, address of residence, date, and then sign. The circulator's complete residential address including municipality of residence must be listed in the certification.
 - The circulator should sign and date the certification only after obtaining signatures. Do not sign beforehand or accept additional signature on the page after signing. You can start a new, additional form to accept new signatures.
 - Circulators and signers can only circulate or sign nomination papers for one candidate for each office; you cannot circulate or sign papers for both Sara Rodriguez and another candidate for Governor.
 - **Please do not number the pages on the bottom of the form.** The campaign will number the pages prior to filing them.
- Circulator should return signed nomination paper(s) to the campaign in person or by mail using the campaign's pre-paid FedEx account. Nomination papers cannot be faxed/ emailed to the filing officer.

The below sample and guide are intended to assist in ensuring nomination papers contain all required information so that signatures are not struck and that Sara Rodriguez can achieve ballot access by submitting the required number of signatures necessary per statute.

Nomination Paper Line Number

1. Acceptable. Well-known acronyms are acceptable for municipalities. The checkmark for Town, Village, or City is not required.
2. Acceptable. If the date above and below the name is acceptable, it can be "bracketed" in and accepted. Ditto marks are acceptable.
3. Unacceptable. Does not list the house number in the address.
4. Acceptable. If the information is contained on the line, it can be moved over. Sister Bay is in the address portion, so this is acceptable.
5. Unacceptable. No signature.
6. Unacceptable. The voter does not list their last name.
7. Unacceptable. The voter lives out of the 1st State Senate District.
8. Unacceptable. The voter signed after the date of the circulator certification.
